SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS AND CONDITIONS

This Scholarship is open to students who intend to study Engineering at University. Proof of entry into an engineering degree course will be required prior to payment of the Scholarship.

The object of this scheme is to provide scholarships annually with each scholarship having a maximum total value of \$2,000 for year one of study. For second and successive years of study either summer vacation employment will be provided, where available and subject to fitness for the role; or a scholarship payment of \$2,000 per annum made. If a scholarship recipient declines the offer of vacation employment, they will not be entitled to a scholarship payment as an alternative. Failure to successfully complete the year's course requirements may affect the Scholarship entitlement at NZAS' discretion.

The scholarships are for children of residents of Southland not employed by NZAS. Applicants should be in Year 13 and be planning to undertake tertiary study for the first time in the year subsequent to their application. Support is provided for the minimum required time to complete the first degree, up to a maximum of 4 years.

APPROVED COURSES AND INSTITUTIONS OF TERTIARY EDUCATION:

- (a) Students to whom scholarships are awarded shall be required to undertake full-time courses in Engineering that lead to graduation at a New Zealand University
- (b) Neither post-graduate study nor a part-time course shall qualify for a scholarship
